POSITION SUMMARY

This position is responsible for managing the risk management information system (RMIS) for a dynamic, privately-held northwest company providing shipping & logistics, air cargo, marine resources, trucking and petroleum distribution services throughout the U.S. The RMIS currently has 100+ users and is the company's database of record for incidents & claims, exposure and policy information. The RMIS manager is charged with developing utilization of the RMIS to the fullest extent possible, from claims administration to exposure and policy management to insurance invoicing and audits.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

The RMIS manager is responsible for integrating existing subsidiaries and newly acquired companies into the RMIS. The RMIS users group is anticipated to grow by at least 10% per year. The RMIS manager will work collaboratively with subsidiary companies to identify their RMIS needs, train personnel and implement solutions consistently across all companies and lines of coverage. As the company's designated system administrator, the RMIS manager will be the RMIS provider's main point of contact. The RMIS manager will develop and implement interfaces with subsidiaries' internal systems, such as HR and Operations; and will implement downloads from external sources, such as insurer loss runs. The RMIS manager will implement RMIS policies and procedures developed by the company to ensure consistent claims administration and documentation across all companies and lines of coverage. The RMIS manager will facilitate RMIS audits by internal audit staff.



This position is also responsible for reporting quarterly safety statistics to executive management; managing claim payments in the company's marine self-insured retention; and assisting the finance team with insurance policy invoicing and payments. This position may be asked to assist on policy renewals, from underwriting submissions to allocations, as needed. This position may be asked to assist with policy audit reconciliation, as needed.
