With a fleet of versatile vessels, Foss offers point to point towing, liner barge operations and critical humanitarian aid to the Caribbean in times of need.



The Isla Bella and Perla Del Caribe sail twice a week between Jacksonville and San Juan, providing reliable shipments of everything from groceries, to construction supplies and raw materials for Puerto Rico's manufacturing industry.

Tropical Shipping services the island direct from and to Canada, and connects all the Caribbean islands from and to Puerto Rico while **Strat Air**

provides daily cargo flights between Miami and San Juan and other Caribbean islands, carrying timesensitive freight.
